Passes are available September 5, 2024 and valid until September 2, 2024.

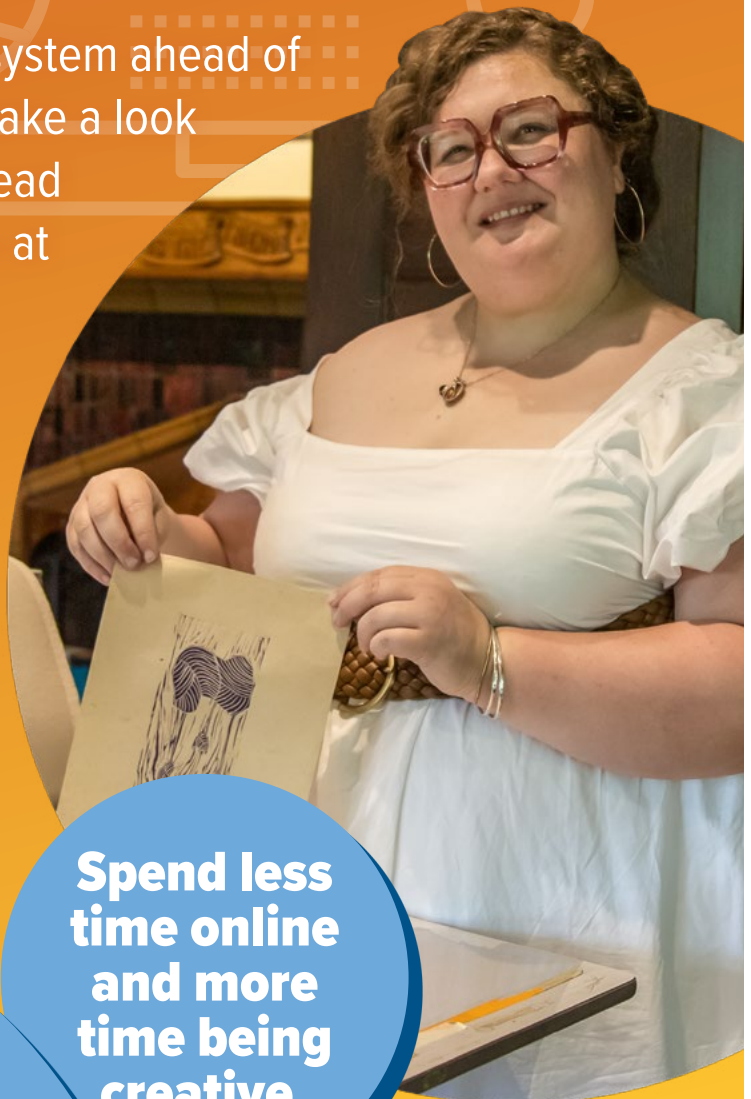

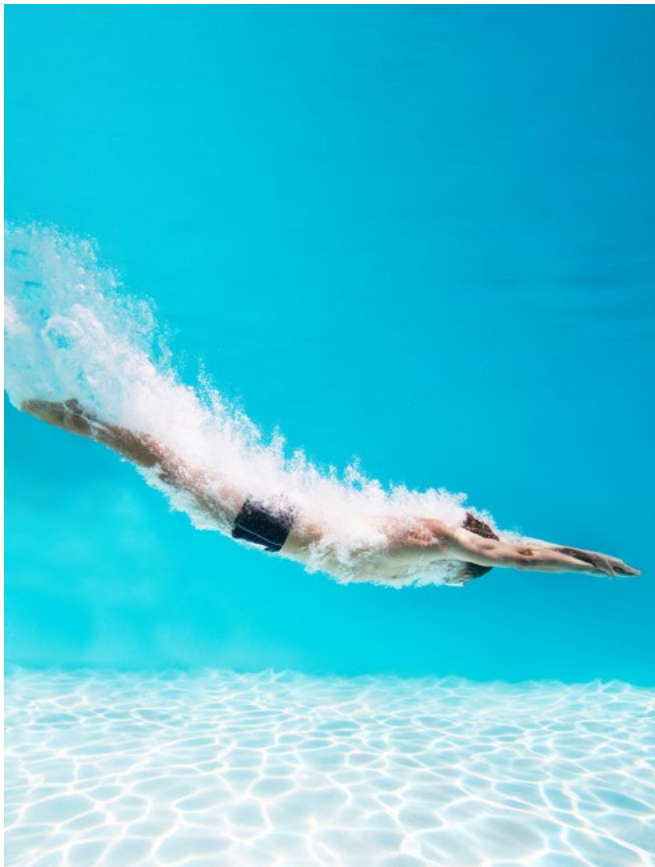
## OUTDOOR AQUATIC SERVICES AND FACILITIES STRATEGY

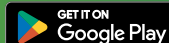
